The school brought the towns up to date on the school budget; announced the contracts have not been settled yet with the 3 unions. Anything added now will be Bourne by the local taxpayer. The Board worries about those people on fixed incomes and advocates for people that cannot pay taxes. Greene's valuation has increased more than Leeds and Turner. The Board would like to have the school department get as much information to the residents before the voting process as possible.

Ron and Tim both said that they are concerned about the increase in taxes but want the best education for children.

Jolene Randall was concerned regarding the Greene Selectmen's tone at the meeting, but felt better after listening to them tonight.

The Board will work with the Superintendent Burdin to get the word out on the change in the voting process. .
