Selectmen's Meeting  
MAY 6, 1996**

Tim called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Kevin read aloud the minutes from April 22, 1996, Moe motioned to accept them, Kevin second it and it was unanimous.

There was Public discussion.

Treasurer's Report - Laurie read aloud the Treasurer's Report.

Roads - Judy reported that the road crew is still working on cleaning up washouts from the last big storm. She also noted that the town will be receiving approximately \$13,000 from FEMA for the winter storm.

Open Dump Day - The Solid Waste Committee discussed the item and the general consensus was that it is pretty much Open Dump Day all the time. The board discussed pursuing a town wide clean up day, most likely to be held in conjunction with Earth Day next year. Moe said he would continue to work on the idea.

Demolition/Construction Debris-After reviewing recommendations from both staff and the Solid Waste Committee Moe motioned that the Transfer Station accept Construction/Demolition materials on Friday, Saturday and Sunday on the 2nd and 4th weekends of the month, William second it and it was unanimous.

June Warrants-Moe motioned to accept articles 1 & 2 for the June 11th, 1996 Special Town Election, Kevin second it and it was unanimous. Kevin motioned to accept articles 1 & 2 of the Special Town Meeting on the 911 Ordinance to be held on June 3rd, 1996 at 7:00 P.M., and that the registrar of voters be available 6:30 P.M. to 7:00 P.M., Moe second it and it was unanimous.

New Stickers For Transfer Station- Judy told the Selectmen that she will have some quotes on new stickers for the Transfer Station at the next meeting.

Solid Waste Contracts-Moe said that the Solid Waste Committee met to discuss the

renewal of the Solid Waste Contracts. They will be meeting again to discuss this item and will bring a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.

**Agreement on Road Crossing-** There was discussion and the Board asked Judy to contact MMA for information at the next workshop and to carry the item on the agenda.

**Other-**There was discussion on possibly getting an LPI assistant to do the leg work on plumbing permits. The Board asked that this item be carried for further discussion.

#### **Committee Reports**

Selectmen signed the weekly warrants.

Tim read aloud the announcements.

At 7:50 P.M. Moe, motioned to adjourn the meeting to an executive session to discuss a personnel matter, Kevin second it and it was unanimous.

At 8:00 P.M. the meeting was unanimously adjourned.
