The Town used the Town of Turner's sweeper; it needs water when used; then the dirt is dumped on the road and picked up by the loader and put into a dump truck. It is very labor intensive due to the style of the machine. The time using this machine is being tracked to analysis the costs to the town using this type of sweeper.

a. Junkyards

Randy Ray updated the Board on the two junkyard complaints that had signed agreements to be cleaned up by June 1st. Randy gave the board copies of the pictures taken today at both locations. The Board and Randy discussed this issue at length. Tim Doyle motioned to turn this over to the town attorney for prosecution. Kevin Mower 2nd the motion. Vote was unanimous. Motion passed.

b. Library Expansion

c. FEMA /Patriots Day Storm

FEMA is reviewing the submissions and photos from Charlie. They have approved approximately half the submissions Total \$70,000: Fed \$52,500 State \$10,500 Town \$6,000). They are still reviewing Morse Cemetery Road, Sedgley Road, Hodgkins Drive, Quaker Ridge and town wide expenses.

The Town Office began issuing burning permits today.

The Board discussed the two personal property accounts that are delinquent. One is paying his payment arrangement and the other one has not.
