

**Greene Board of Selectmen

July 14, 2003**

**I. Call to Order 7:00 PM**

Ron Grant called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

**II. Public Discussion**

Ron Grant announced the Board met with delinquent foreclosed taxpayers before this meeting in Executive Session. They have worked out a plan for payment.

**III. Acceptance of Minutes – July 7, 2003**

Timothy Doyle motioned to waive the reading of the minutes, to approve the acceptance of the minutes of the July 7th meeting upon signature of Chairman, Ronald Grant. Kevin Mower 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Vote was unanimous. Motion passed.

**IV. Unfinished Business**

**a. Treasurer's Report**

There was no treasurer's report in the Selectmen's packet tonight. Steve announced the balance as of July 14<sup>th</sup> is \$58,940.00. Excise tax collection is currently 10% higher than June 2003. The Board underestimated the State Revenue Sharing income for the year 2003.

**b. Roads**

Steve reported that the Highway crew is grading and taking out the slope on Patten Road. They keep grading the reclaimed areas to keep the roads smooth. The roadside mowing is ongoing throughout the summer. The culverts have been delivered for College Road at R & S for assembling before installation.

c. **Fire Station Construction**

Steve reported that insulation is being installed. The brickwork is almost complete and the roof over the main office section is complete. Tim Doyle and Steve toured the station before the meeting.

d. **Fire Truck Contract**

Bruce Tufts, Fire Chief, and Steve Eldridge, Town Manager, sat down with EVM and discussed upgrading equipment on the fire truck, changed some apparatus, discussed the payment schedule. The chassis is being delivered in September and the truck should be completed with 170 days. Kevin Mower motioned to allow Steve to sign the apparatus contract for \$256,748.00 for the new fire truck. Mark Christman 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Vote was unanimous. Motion passed.

e. **Other**

Steve reported that the vandalism has cut down at the Fire Station and Transfer Station.

V. **New Business**

a. **Town Office Roof**

Steve reported that he sent out requests for proposal to replace the shingles on the front side of the Greene Town Office; only two bids were received. The bid was awarded to Fortin & Sons.

b. **MMA Nominations**

Timothy Doyle motioned to vote for William Bridgeo for MMA, the rest of the positions are uncontested and the town manager is to check them off. Maurice Levasseur 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Vote for the motion – Maurice Levasseur, Timothy Doyle, Ronald Grant. Vote against the motion – Kevin Mower, Mark Christman. Motion passed.

c. **Legal**

Tim Doyle reported that he and Steve met with the Budget Committee to go over the budget report.

Ron Grant and Steve reported that the Julia Adams Morse Library Addition Committee met with the architect. He is to prepare the bid documents for the next meeting in September. The Bids should go out in December for the town to vote on in March.

Kevin Mower reported the Planning Board has a full agenda for the next meeting.

Ron Grant reported that the new superintendent met with him. They discussed how important the school is to the community, and where it should be headed, and the building goals are in plans.

**XI. Executive Session**

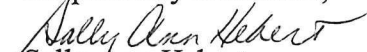
There was none discussed at this meeting.
