

**Greene Board of Selectmen
Regular Meeting
November 13, 2006**

I. Call to Order

Ronald Grant, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

II. Public Discussion

Brenda Theriault representing the Women's Club of Greene reminded people to donate to the Xmas Project 2006. She has received more requests to provide Christmas for the needy and needs people to adopt a senior, adopt a child, adopt a family, donations of money, gift certificates, etc. to call her to ask how they can help.

III. Acceptance of Minutes – October 30, 2006

Tony Reny motioned to waive the reading on the minutes, to approve the acceptance of the minutes dated October 30th meeting upon signature of Chairman, Ronald Grant. Kevin Mower 2nd the motion. Vote was unanimous. Motion passed.

Ron read a memo from Sally Ann Hebert that nominations papers for the March 2 election will be available December 7th. The positions available are: Tim Doyle and Ron Grant's position for Board of Selectmen (includes Assessor and Overseer of Poor) and Diana Morgan position for MSAD 52 School Board Director (she is going to run).

The Board reviewed the memo from RJD Appraisal on the \$380,700 gain in valuation picked up during the quarterly review.

Kevin Mower reported that the Land Use Ordinance Review Committee meeting was cancelled.

Tony Reny reported that Dan Moreno, Architect from Julia Adams Morse Library Addition will present to the Planning Board tomorrow night.


