The Board heard from the Code Enforcement Officer David Leeman and he reported that the applicant's sites were found in order.

On a motion made by Tim and seconded by Moe, the Board voted to approve the junkyard permits for Arthur Nystrom, Alton Johnson, and Alton Perkins. The Board signed all documents.

It was noted that the Public hearing on the Appeals Board and Conservation Commission Ordinance Changes was changed to January 8th.

Tim noted that there was a need to finalize the vote on the Drug Testing for all Town Commerical Class Drivers. Judy stated that she had attempted to contact the school but unfortunately was unable to make contact. She also noted that the contracts in question were not at all binding and the town could withdraw from either whenever they felt dissatisfied with the service. After some discussion and on a motion made by Tim and seconded by Moe, the Board voted to allow Judy to enter into an agreement with Maine Motor Transport for this testing.
