Call to Order

John Soucy called meeting to order at 5:02 P.M.

Discussion on Last Meeting of 8/17/20

Soucy states the following was discussed at the Sept 14th, 2020 meeting: finalizing the punch card, changing from two year to one year card. Construction debris will be added to the card. Residents will be able to be disposed of one load of construction debris at no cost. Contractors will no longer be permitted to dispose at the Transfer Station, they must go to Auburn. License plate # will be put on the punch card. Land Lords are permitted to get stickers for tenants if they do not have a dumpster. They will not get a punch card. The license plate number will also be put on the sticker. Residents who have homestead will get a punch card. Punch Card will be a \$3.00 fee.

Fee Schedule

Soucy asked Adam if he can review the fee schedule and put down the Town cost for Andy Valley to take away.

Waste Oil

Roger Dulac called on a clean burn building. There would be a fee to dispose of motor oil. Soucy states that is something they need to discuss further and budget for.

Brush

Beaulieu states she spoke to a gentleman who will be removing the brush; he will chip it and remove it. Once it is gone, the Town will no longer take brush. That area will be used for the placement of a shack.

Shack

The shack will be a pre-inspection site at the Transfer Station. The attendants will have hand held radios for communication back and forth.

When residents come up to the gate their vehicle will be inspected and directed where to go. Contractors will be turned around.

Soucy states they need to decide what size shack to have. He doesn't think they need anything too big. Beaulieu suggests they go look around to see what other Towns have. Adam states there needs to be a determination to where the shack will be placed because it may be too close to the land fill. DEP approval may be needed.

Other

Soucy states it's important to get notices out to the residents about the changes that will be happening, especially with the elimination of the brush and leaf pile. Tires with rims will not be accepted.
