To Alden P. Peterson, a resident of the Town of Greene, in the County of Androscoggin.

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the voters of the Town of Greene, in said County, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Municipal Office Building, in said town, on Monday the 19th day of June, A.D. 1995 at 7:00 o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on Articles 1 through 3, all said articles being set out below to wit:

Article 1: To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.


Article 2: To see if the town will authorize the Selectmen now and in the future when necessary to enter into easement agreements with property owners for the reconstructing or possible relocation of existing roads or act in any relation thereto.


Article 3: To see if the town will authorize the Selectmen to enter into an easement agreement with the State of Maine Inland Fisheries & Wildlife to allow monies to be expended for a walk-in boat launch site on Allen Pond.


